PARK NEWS

Council has decided to implement a watercraft pass system beginning this year. The purpose of this system is to better manage the use of the harbor and ensure safety. The pass system will work in the following manner:

- North Perry residents with any type of watercraft must register in advance at the North Perry Village Hall.
- The cost for registration is **\$10 per watercraft**.
- The resident needs to bring the registration number of their watercraft, the type of watercraft and a basic description of the watercraft.
- The resident will be issued a mirror hanger tag that will be hung in their vehicle each time the watercraft is brought to the park.
- The registration process and distribution of the hanger tags will begin May 1st.
- Registration of watercraft is required annually.

A major change from the past is that **no visiting watercraft will be allowed**. Residents may bring visitors to the park **but not the visitor's watercraft**.

Park passes were deactivated on December 30, 2016.

Reactivating your pass will require the following:

1. Stop in at the Village Hall to fill out a form for 2017.
Bring your Park Pass with you.
2. Show proof of residency
3. Pay a Ten Dollar fee (\$10) per pass
4. To replace a lost pass, the fee is Twenty Dollars (\$20)

Village Hall hours are from 9:00am to 5:00pm Monday-Friday. The Village Hall is open until 6:30pm on the first and third Thursday of the month. Updated 2017 passes must be activated for access to the park.

FYI

- Please remember when buying and renewing your license plates at the BMV that you make sure your address is listed as **North Perry Village**. This will ensure the Village receives the fees.
- Notary service is available at the Village Hall.
- Please clean up after your pet as you walk around the village.
- North Perry Village has an opening on the Perry Area Recreation Board and on the Planning Commission. Residents interested in either of these positions may call the Village Hall at: (440)259-4994 or e-mail at secretary@northperry.org.

NEWSLETTER CHANGES

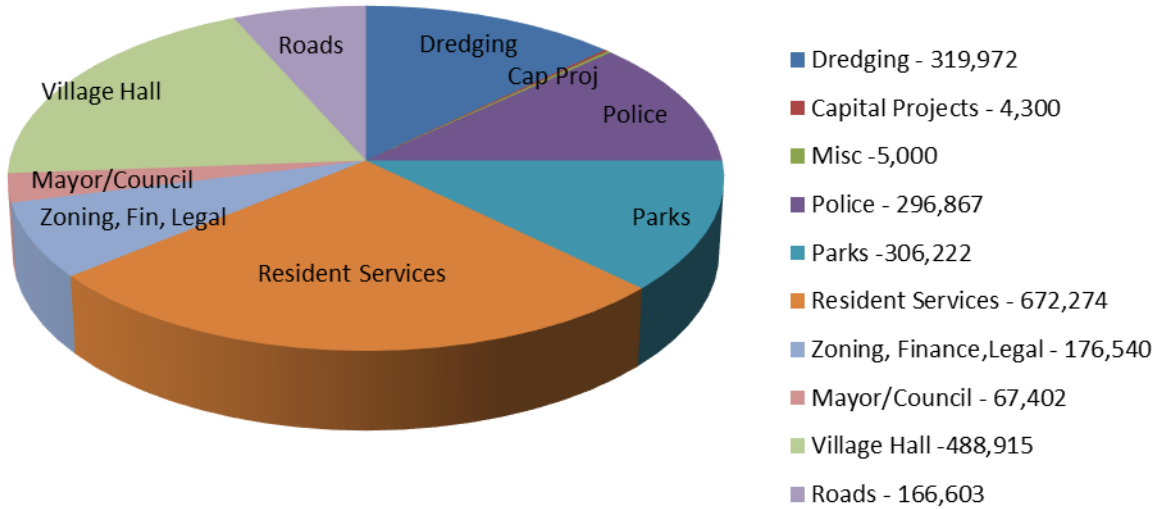
