## **FROM THE ROAD COMMISSIONER**

### **FALL LEAF PICK UP:**

- The final leaf removal day is December 16<sup>th</sup>. Leaves to be collected after this date must be bagged to be removed.

## FYI

- Please remember when buying and renewing your license plates at the BMV that you make sure your address is listed as **North Perry Village**. This will insure the Village receives the fees.
- Notary service is available at the Village Hall.
- Council is asking for volunteers for an Ad Hoc committee to explore options for cable television and internet for the Village. Residents interested may call the Village Hall at (440)259-4994 or e-mail at [secretary@northperry.org](mailto:secretary@northperry.org).
- **Garbage and Recycling pickups will not be delayed due to Christmas and New Year's Day being on a Sunday this year. Please have your totes out on December 26<sup>th</sup> and January 2<sup>nd</sup>. December 26<sup>th</sup> is also recycling pickup. Totes need to be at the curb before 7:00am.**
- If you tend to have more recycling than garbage making it necessary to have a larger tote for recycling, the lids on the totes can be switched. Please call the Village Hall to request this change.
- The holidays and year-end are precursors of tax season, unfortunately. Please remember that village taxes are due to CCA in April along with state and federal. BUT if you have not had ANY taxes taken out of your payroll or have not paid any estimated taxes from retirement or dividends, you must send a substantial portion of estimated 2016 tax to CCA by January 31, 2017.

Forms are online thru CCA. We will request hard copy forms for the Village in January.

## PARK NEWS

Park passes will be deactivated on December 30, 2016. Reactivating your pass will require the following:

1. Stop in at the Village Hall to fill out a form for 2017
2. Show proof of residency
3. Pay a Ten Dollar fee (\$10) per pass
4. To replace a lost pass the fee is Twenty Dollars (\$20)

Village Hall hours are from 9:00am to 5:00pm Monday-Friday. The Village Hall is open until 6:30pm on the first and third Thursday of the month. Updated 2017 passes must be activated for access to the park.
