We are in the process of finalizing a contract with Spectrum (Time Warner) for cable TV for the Village. This contract could potentially save the Village a considerable amount of money and still provide the same service. We will update you as information is available.

The Village has representatives from Council on the Joint Economic Development District (JEDD), the Perry Fire Board, the Lake County Development Council (LCDC), and the Perry Economic Development Council (PEDC) to name a few. ## **FYI**

- Please remember when buying and renewing your license plates at the BMV that you make sure your address is listed as **North Perry Village**. This will ensure the Village receives the fees.
- Notary service is available at the Village Hall.
- If you tend to have more recycling than garbage, making it necessary to have a larger tote for recycling, the lids on the totes can be switched. Please call the Village Hall to request this change.
- The holidays and year-end are precursors of tax season, unfortunately. Please remember that village taxes are due to CCA in April along with state and federal. BUT if you have not had ANY taxes taken out of your payroll or have not paid any estimated taxes from retirement or dividends, you must send a substantial portion of estimated 2016 tax to CCA by January 31, 2017.

## **PARK NEWS**

Park passes were deactivated on December 30, 2016. Reactivating your pass will require the following:

1. Stop in at the Village Hall to fill out a form for 2017. Bring your Park Pass with you.
2. Show proof of residency
3. Pay a Ten Dollar fee (\$10) per pass
4. To replace a lost pass the fee is Twenty Dollars (\$20)

Village Hall hours are from 9:00am to 5:00pm Monday-Friday. The Village Hall is open until 6:30pm on the first and third Thursday of the month. Updated 2017 passes must be activated for access to the park.
