From the Mayor

Hello Residents,

I had the opportunity to attend 2017 graduation ceremony at Perry High School. Ten graduated from the Class of 2017 live in North Perry Village. Council and I would like to congratulate all of our graduates.

Dredging at the harbor has been going well. Haynes Construction has been dredging the harbor as needed this spring. Dredging costs have decreased dramatically. In June of 2016 dredging costs totaled approximately Two Hundred Thirty-Two Thousand Dollars (\$232,000). As of June 5, 2017, the cost for dredging the harbor this year is Forty-Seven Thousand Three Hundred Eight Dollars (\$47,308). With removal of the east groin the water is flowing better.

If you have been charged for movie channels from Spectrum, please call the Village Hall at the number listed above. During the transition from Time Warner to Spectrum, residents have been mistakenly charged for movie channels that are included in the North Perry Village package.

PARK NEWS

Council has decided to implement a watercraft pass system beginning this year. The purpose of this system is to better manage the use of the harbor and ensure safety. The pass system will work in the following manner:

- North Perry residents with any type of watercraft must register **in advance** at the North Perry Village Hall.
- The cost for registration is **\$10 per watercraft**.
- The resident needs to bring the registration of their watercraft, the type of watercraft and a basic description of the watercraft.
- The resident will be issued a mirror hanger tag that will be hung in their vehicle each time the watercraft is brought to the park.
- The registration process and distribution of the hanger tags will begin May 1st.
- Registration of watercraft is required annually.

A major change from the past is that **no visiting watercraft will be allowed**. Residents may bring visitors to the park **but not the visitor's watercraft**.

Park passes were deactivated on December 30, 2016.

Reactivating your pass will require the following:

1. Stop in at the Village Hall to fill out a form for 2017.
Bring your Park Pass with you.
2. Show proof of residency
3. Pay a Ten Dollar fee (\$10) per pass
4. To replace a lost pass, the fee is Twenty Dollars (\$20)

Village Hall hours are from 8:30am to 12:30pm Monday-Friday. The Village Hall is open Thursday, June 15th 8:30am to 12:30pm and from 5:00pm to 6:30pm. Updated 2017 passes must be activated for access to the park.

FYI

- Please remember when buying and renewing your license plates at the BMV that you make sure your address is listed as **North Perry Village**. This will ensure the Village receives the fees.
- Notary service is available at the Village Hall.
- Please clean up after your pet as you walk around the village.

FROM THE ROAD COMMISSIONER

Please remember while doing your spring cleanup that all leaves must be bagged for pickup. Free bags are provided at the Village Hall. Please have the bagged leaves out near the curb before 7:00am Tuesday morning.
