Hello Residents,

Council and I always strived to be responsible in managing the budget. As we near the close of 2017, we would like to communicate to you some of the budget savings. The approximate savings are as follows:

Spectrum bill -	\$200,000
Harbor dredging -	200,000
Harbor modification –	83,000
Adjustment in staff –	<u>100,000</u>
	\$583,000 (Savings)

Fiscal Officer, Joanne Clapp has saved the Village money with some banking adjustment regarding bank fees. Reviewing the cell phone bill and making adjustments has saved the Village approximately \$150 a month. The Village applied for and received a grant (319 Grant) to help with the cost to fix drainage problems. Also, the Village has received the final settlement of \$275,000 from JJR.

In closing, I would like to thank the Council for their hard work and dedication.
