FROM THE ROAD COMMISSIONER

FALL LEAF PICK UP:

- Leaves to be collected should be gathered into a pile in the grass area next to the road edge.
- DO NOT PILE LEAVES IN THE ROAD
- DO NOT MIX GRASS & TWIGS & BRANCHES with leaves to be collected.
- Weekly fall leaf pick-up began Monday, October 17th and ends Friday, December 16th this year.
- Please refrain from mowing your grass onto the roadways. Storm water collects the grass and it accumulates around catch basins, causing poor drainage.
