

RESOLUTION NO. R17-10

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A REPLACEMENT TRUCK FOR STREETS FOR THE VILLAGE AT A COST NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY-EIGHT THOUSAND FOUR HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$58,400), AND FOR THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ENCUMBER AND EXPEND THE FUNDS NECESSARY TO ACCOMPLISH SAME

WHEREAS, North Perry Village is in need of replacement truck for streets for North Perry Village; and

WHEREAS, the Village believes the sum of Fifty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$58,400.00) is reasonable for the purchase of a replacement truck for the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of a replacement truck for the Village at a cost not to exceed Fifty-Eight Thousand Four Hundred Dollars (\$58,400.00) and the Fiscal Officer is authorized to encumber and expend the funds necessary to accomplish same.

Section 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon the earliest time allowable by law.
