

RESOLUTION NO. R017-14

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF JOANNE CLAPP AS FISCAL OFFICER AND OFFICE MANAGER FOR THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, A PART-TIME, NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY-FIVE (25) HOURS PER WEEK, VILLAGE EMPLOYMENT POSITION, COMMENCING JUNE 1, 2017, WITH A PAID EMPLOYMENT TRAINING PERIOD BEGINNING ON OR ABOUT MAY 22, 2017, AT AN ANNUAL SALARY OF EIGHTEEN THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$18,000.00), AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Mayor for the Village of North Perry has recommended for approval the appointment of Joanne Clapp as the Fiscal Officer and Office Manager for the Village of North Perry, a part-time, not more than twenty-five (25) hours per week, Village employment position, commencing June 1, 2017, with a paid employment training period beginning on or about May 22, 2017, at an annual salary of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000); and

WHEREAS, the Village Council is desirous of approving said appointment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The appointment of Joanne Clapp as the Fiscal Officer and Office Manager for the Village of North Perry, a part-time, not more than twenty-five (25) hours per week, Village employment position, commencing June 1, 2017, with a paid employment training period beginning on or about May 22, 2017, at an annual salary of Eighteen Thousand Dollars (\$18,000.00) is hereby approved.

SECTION 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3 This Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency Resolution, the emergency being the necessity to fill the position of Village Fiscal Officer and Office Manager. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of North Perry.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
