

RESOLUTION NO. R17-18

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT FOR THE SALE OF VILLAGE PROPERTY, TO-WIT: PERMANENT PARCEL NO. 05A013B000180, AT A COST OF SIXTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$60,000.00) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council previously solicited bids for the sale of Village owned real estate; and

WHEREAS, Council now wishes to accept a bid from Steve and Cindy Rogaski in the amount of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the purchase of Permanent Parcel No. 05A013B000180.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Village of North Perry hereby accepts the bid from Steve and Cindy Rogaski for the sum of Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00) for the purchase of Village owned property, Permanent Parcel No. 05A013B000180, and hereby authorizes the Mayor to enter into a contract with Steve and Cindy Rogaski for the sale of same.

SECTION 2. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 3. This Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency Resolution, the emergency being the immediate necessity to allow the immediate transfer of the property. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of North Perry.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage.
