

TOWNLINER PARK PASS OPTIONS AND ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Residential Park Pass
 - Any person who is a resident of North Perry Village shall be entitled to a Townline Park Residential Park Pass.
 - To acquire a Townline Park Residential Park Pass, proof of residency within North Perry Village, Ohio shall be required.
 - A Townline Park Residential Park Pass shall entitle the holder to full park use and privileges as set forth in the Townline Park Regulations.
 - This Residential Park Pass is currently in place with no changes.

- Landowner Residential Park Pass
 - Each landowner and family members residing in household shall be entitled to a Townline Park Residential Park Pass.
 - To acquire a Townline Park Residential Park Pass, proof of ownership of property within North Perry Village, Ohio shall be required.
 - A Townline Park Residential Park Pass entitles the holder to full park use and privileges as set forth in the Townline Park Regulations.

- Employee Park Pass
 - Each full time and part time North Perry Village employee and family members residing in household shall be entitled to a Townline Park Employee Park Pass.
 - To acquire a Townline Park Employee Park Pass, proof of full time or part time employment with North Perry Village shall be required.
 - A Townline Park Employee Park Pass shall entitle the holder to full park use and privileges as set forth in the Townline Park Regulations.

- Seasonal Employee Park Pass
 - Each seasonal employee of North Perry Village shall be entitled to a Townline Park Seasonal Employee Park Pass.
 - To acquire a Townline Park Seasonal Employee Park Pass, proof of seasonal employment with North Perry Village shall be required.
 - A Townline Park Seasonal Employee Park Pass shall entitle the holder to full park use except for the following. A Seasonal Park Pass holder shall not have boat launch access privileges. A Seasonal Park Pass holder shall be limited to one guest per visit to the Park.

- Madison Township Park Pass
 - Madison Township residents residing on Townline Road north of Northridge Road who are permanent residents shall be entitled to a Townline Park Madison Resident Park Pass.
 - To acquire a Townline Park Madison Resident Park Pass, proof of permanent residency shall be required.
 - A Townline Park Madison Resident Park Pass shall entitle the holder to have walk in access only to the park (no dock/boat privileges.)
 - Townline Park privileges are for residents only, no guests.
 - This Madison Township Park Pass is currently in place with no changes.

- Weekly Family Pass
 - Ten such passes shall be available for each week.
 - Any person acquiring a Townline Park Village Residential Park Pass is eligible to purchase one Weekly Family Pass per week.
 - To acquire a Townline Park One week Family Pass, the purchaser must show proof of ownership of a North Perry Village Residential Pass and pay a fee of \$50.00 and a deposit of \$50.00 for a total of \$100.00. Only ten such passes may be issued per week. Sale of the passes will be on a first come, first serve basis.
 - A Townline Park Weekly Family Pass shall entitle the holder to full park use as set forth in the Townline Park Regulations, except for the following: a Weekly Family Pass holder will not be able to utilize the community center for parties or bring additional guests/watercraft to the park.
 - The Weekly Family Pass will not require the North Perry resident to stay with the family at the park.
 - A Week is defined as from Monday to Sunday.
 - When the Weekly Family Pass is turned in to the Village Hall secretary by Tuesday at 5 p.m. the following week, the \$50.00 deposit will be returned by check within 7 business days.
 - **The Weekly Family Pass will not be issued during the weeks of May 25th (Memorial Day), June 29th (Independence Day), and Sept. 7th (Labor Day).**

- Seasonal Family Pass
 - Fifteen such passes shall be available for each calendar year.
 - Any person acquiring a North Perry Village Residential Park Pass is eligible to purchase one Seasonal Family Pass.
 - To acquire a Townline Park Seasonal Family Pass, the purchaser must show proof of ownership of a North Perry Village Residential Pass and pay a fee of \$200.00. Only fifteen such passes may be issued per calendar year. Sale of the passes will be on a first come, first serve basis.

- A Townline Park Seasonal Family Pass shall entitle the holder to full park use as set forth in the Townline Park Regulations, except for the following: a Seasonal Family Pass holder will not be able to utilize the community center for parties or bring additional guests/watercraft to the park.
- The Seasonal Family Pass will not require the North Perry resident to stay with the family at the park.
- The Seasonal Family Pass expires at the end of the calendar year. The pass must be returned to the Village Hall secretary by the first Tuesday of the new calendar year.

Family is defined as: A fundamental social group in society consisting of one or two parents and their children.

ALL PASS HOLDERS MUST ABIDE BY THE GENERAL PARK, POOL AND COMMUNITY CENTER RULES AS FROM TIME TO TIME MAY BE AMENDED.
