

Record of Proceedings

Mayor Ed Klco called the North Perry Village Council Work Session to order at 6:02 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag of the United States of America.

Guest – Consultant John Senz talked to council about assisting village with an economic development plan.

Old Business:

Webpage – Mayor Klco stated he did not get the information from the county about the webpage. Possibility of current employee maintaining normal input on village website. Further discussion and research needed.

Townline Rd Ext – discussion held on different options for village to take. Dwayne and Mayor will research and will discuss at next work session.

Kevin Michael Estates – Waiting for Lake County Soil and Water and the Village Engineer to do site evaluation.

Rec Board donation – Mayor Klco reported we had first reading for legislation for \$10,000 to the Perry Rec Board and \$7,500 to the Senior Center. Last year they requested a total of \$22,000, we gave them \$20,000 and stated in a letter we were going to start cutting back on our donation. Phil Cassella from Perry Rec Board will be at February Council meeting to explain why they need \$22,000.

Council discussed the need of a policy put into place to require Business Financial statements, when a group requests financial assistance from the Village.

Department Reports:

Mayor

Mayor Klco reported South Shore has lost possession of the property, they do not know if they are going to stay at their current location or move. They would like to remain in North Perry.

Mayor Klco stated he does not know where the Wind Project is going. Juhl Wind is still working on it.

Mayor Klco stated Dwayne, Joe Gurley and himself will be going into Cleveland around January 17th for mediation for the Harbor.

Council

Mike Cutler stated council would like to see budgets for each department broken down by line item to review. Hoping to get a better view of expenses.

Mike Cutler asked if work on the drainage project will be removing the material or banking it. Dwayne Bailey stated it would be removed.

Larry Klco stated he has been approached by residents about getting less cable channels and acquire internet access. Mayor Klco explained the way the original contract was written; if we make any changes, it would cost the Village more than we are willing to pay.

Larry Klco stated he has talked with residents who have the Medical Alert system and are not using them because they are afraid of setting them off unintentionally.

Larry Reichard stated he has received complaints about pushing snow across the road onto the sidewalks. Chief Radovanic stated he would take care of it.

Ken Siegel asked Steve Sabol if he used rubber on the snowplow blade of the coyote. He has used it at work and it works well. Steve stated they just have the metal blades.

Finance Director

Chief Radovanic stated the department will participate in training for a hostile takeover at the Power Plant.

Chief Radovanic reported Mayor Klco and himself will be meeting with Perry Village and Township about police regionalization.

Zoning Inspector

Dwayne Bailey stated everyone should have received a copy via email of the Monitoring Study.

Road Commissioner

Steve Sabol stated he bought replacement blades for the coyote. He will work with Dwayne on getting rubber to add to the blades.
