**Department Reports:**

**Road Commissioner**

Mayor Klco read Steve Sabol's report. The leaf vac saved the village about half what we paid to have outside service. Disposing of leaves at Losely's on Antioch, another savings on time and fuel. Pedestrian signs have been installed on Parmly Rd.
