

**ORDINANCE NO. 15-06**

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 521.07 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY RELATING TO FENCES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of North Perry has determined that it is desirable and necessary to eliminate the electric fence prohibition within the Village.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY VILLAGE, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** Section 521.07 of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of North Perry is hereby amended to read as follows:

**521.07 FENCES.**

- (a) No person shall erect or maintain a barbed wire fence which abuts or is adjacent to any public street or sidewalk. This subsection (b) does not prevent the placement and use of not more than three strands of barbed wire on top of a fence other than a barbed wire fence, provided such strands are not less than seventy-two inches from the ground.
- (b) Whoever violates this section is guilty of a minor misdemeanor.

**Section 2.** Upon the effective date of this Ordinance, the Clerk of Council of the Village of North Perry, Ohio shall make available to all members of Council, and any members of the public, when required, copies of this amendment to the Codified Ordinances of the Village of North Perry, Ohio.

**Section 3.** The severability provisions of the Codified Ordinances Section 101.08 shall be applicable to this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its committees, which result in formal actions, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all requirements included in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5.** That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency Ordinance, the emergency being the immediate necessity to eliminate the electric fence prohibition. Said Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of North Perry.

**WHEREFORE**, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
