

**ORDINANCE NO. 15-07**

**ORDINANCE ELIMINATING THE EMPLOYMENT REQUIREMENT THAT THE VILLAGE PARKS DIRECTOR RESIDE AT THE VILLAGE OWNED RESIDENCE LOCATED AT THE VILLAGE PARK AND INCREASING HER SALARY TO OFFSET HER LOSS OF THIS RESIDENCY BENEFIT**

**WHEREAS**, as a condition of her employment, the North Perry Village Parks Director resides in the Village owned residence located at the Village Park;

**WHEREAS**, the Village Parks Director and the Village have had discussions concerning the removal of the aforementioned residence requirement as a condition of employment for the Village Parks Director; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council and the Village Parks Director agree that the Village Parks Director should no longer be required to reside at the Park and that upon vacating her current residence at the Village Park, the Village Parks Director should receive an increase in compensation to replace the loss of the residency benefit.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY VILLAGE, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1.** The Village Parks Director shall no longer be required to reside in the Village owned residence located at the Village Park.

**Section 2.** The current annual compensation being paid the Village Parks Director by the Village shall be increased by One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) per month, commencing June 1, 2015, contingent upon the Village Parks Director and her family moving out of the residence by said date.

**Section 3.** The severability provisions of the Codified Ordinances Section 101.08 shall be applicable to this Ordinance.

**Section 4.** That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its committees, which result in formal actions, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all requirements included in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the earliest date allowable by law.
