

ORDINANCE NO. 16-04

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE RECODIFICATION, EDITING AND INCLUSION OF CERTAIN ORDINANCES AS PARTS OF THE VARIOUS COMPONENT CODES OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, various ordinances of a general and permanent nature have been passed which should be included in the Codified Ordinances of North Perry, Ohio;

WHEREAS, numerous sections in the Traffic, General Offenses and Fire Prevention Codes need to be amended or enacted in order to conform with State law;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section 1. That the recodification, editing, arrangement and numbering or renumbering of the following ordinances and parts of ordinances are hereby approved as parts of the various component codes of the Codified Ordinances of the Village of North Perry, so as to conform to the classification and numbering system of the Codified Ordinances, to wit:

Section 3. The complete text of the Traffic, General Offenses and Fire Prevention Code sections listed above are set forth in full in the 2016 replacement pages to the Codified Ordinances which are hereby attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A. Any summary publication of this ordinance shall include a complete listing of these sections. Notice of adoption of each new section by reference to its title shall constitute sufficient publication of new matter contained therein.

Section 4. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of North Perry and for the further reason of the lack of local ordinances to enforce newly amended or enacted sections in the Traffic, General Offenses and Fire Prevention Codes. Therefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
