

## ORDINANCE NO. 16-11

### AN ORDINANCE REVISING THE VILLAGE'S FARMLAND PRESERVATION PROGRAM GUIDELINES AND SELECTION CONSIDERATIONS.

**WHEREAS**, the Village adopted Farmland Preservation Program Guidelines and Selection Considerations pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 15-10; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village desires to amend the provisions of said Program Guidelines and Selection Considerations to better serve the residents of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE, STATE OF OHIO**, as follows:

**Section 1.** The Village Farmland Preservation Program Guidelines and Selection Considerations established pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance No. 15-10 are amended to include the following steps:

- 1) North Perry Village property owner contacts the Mayor.
- 2) The Mayor fills out the questionnaire with the property owner of the property being considered.
- 3) The Mayor presents information to council for approval.
- 4) If approved by council, the information is sent to Soil and Water for Farmland application consideration (letter sent to Soil and Water from North Perry Village showing support and funds available).
- 5) The Mayor contacts the property owner of the results of the process.

All provisions of Ordinance 15-10 not amended by the provision of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

**Section 2.** The severability provisions of the Codified Ordinances Section 101.08 shall be applicable to this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its committees, which result in formal actions, were in meeting open to the public, in compliance with all requirements included in Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 4.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon the earliest date allowable by law.
