## **RESOLUTION NO. R13-22**

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A PAY INCREASE TO FOURTEEN AND 50/100THS DOLLARS (\$14.50) PER HOUR FOR JOSH PINKNEY AND CHRIS HAZEL COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2014 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council desires to increase the compensation to Fourteen and 50/100<sup>th</sup> Dollars (\$14.50) per hour for Josh Pinkney and Chris Hazel beginning January 1, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1.** That the compensation for Josh Pinkney and Chris Hazel be increased to Fourteen and 50/100<sup>th</sup> Dollars (\$14.50) per hour.
- **SECTION 2.** That said increase in compensation set forth in this Resolution shall be effective on and after January 1, 2014, and shall remain in effect at such rate unless otherwise modified by Village Council.
- **SECTION 3.** That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
- **SECTION 4.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency Resolution, the emergency being the immediate necessity for the timely compensation increase. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of North Perry.

**WHEREFORE**, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
