

**RESOLUTION NO. R13-26**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE APPOINTMENT OF ANTHONY ILIANO AS SERGEANT FOR THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, A FULL-TIME FORTY (40) HOURS PER WEEK VILLAGE EMPLOYMENT POSITION, COMMENCING JANUARY 1, 2014, AT A RATE OF TWENTY DOLLARS (\$20.00) PER HOUR, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor for the Village of North Perry has recommended for approval the appointment of Anthony Iliano as Sergeant for the Village of North Perry, a full-time forty (40) hours per week Village employment position, commencing January 1, 2014, at the rate of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per hour; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Council is desirous of approving said appointment.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The appointment of Anthony Iliano as Sergeant for the Village of North Perry, a full-time forty (40) hours per week Village employment position, commencing January 1, 2014, at the rate of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) per hour, is hereby approved.

**SECTION 2.** That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**SECTION 3.** This Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency Resolution, the emergency being the necessity to fill the position of Assistant Police Chief for the year 2014. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of North Perry.

**WHEREFORE**, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
