

RESOLUTION NO. R15-13

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO SELL A 2009 CROWN VICTORIA POLICE VEHICLE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village currently owns a police vehicles, to-wit: a 2009 Crown Victoria; hereinafter referred to as "the Vehicle," and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle is no longer needed for municipal purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Vehicle has a value in excess of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Village Council desires to sell the Vehicle through govdeal.com.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. It is determined by the Village Council that the Vehicle is no longer needed for a Village purpose and that the Vehicle has a value that exceeds One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).

SECTION 2. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to sell the Vehicle through govdeal.com.

SECTION 3. That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

SECTION 4. This Resolution is hereby declared to be and is passed as an emergency Resolution, the emergency being the immediate need to sell the unneeded vehicle. Said Resolution is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the Village of North Perry.

WHEREFORE, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage by Council.
