

# RESOLUTION NO. R15-22

## RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. R04-51 BY ADDING CERTAIN ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR PROSPECTIVE PARTICIPANTS IN THE VILLAGE'S UPDATED SIGNAGE COST REIMBURSEMENT PROGRAM

**WHEREAS**, Council for North Perry Village desires to add certain eligibility requirements for prospective participants in the Village's updated signage cost reimbursement program.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NORTH PERRY, COUNTY OF LAKE AND STATE OF OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** The Village's updated signage cost reimbursement program, as set forth in Resolution No. R04-51, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to expend up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500), on a one-time-only basis, to individual business owners for new or replacement of old signage with updated signage and/or new or updated landscaping within the Village of North Perry, when:

- a. the business owner is in compliance with the provisions of Chapters 171 of the Codified Ordinances of North Perry Village;
- b. the signage or signage landscaping to be updated has been displayed in place for no less than one (1) year;
- c. the placement of the signage to be updated was done in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 1109 of the Codified Ordinances of North Perry Village;
- d. the business owner has obtained a zoning permit for the new updated signage pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 1109.01 of the Codified Ordinances of North Perry Village;
- e. the installation of the new updated signage is complete;
- f. the costs involved with the purchase and installation of the new updated signage, along with all corresponding bills that substantiate same, have been submitted to the Construction Director for review; and
- g. the Director of Construction has determined the cost of reimbursement, and notified the Fiscal Officer of his approval of said expenditure.

**SECTION 2.** An eligible commercial business is a commercial business that is located within the Village of North Perry upon property used exclusively for business purposes, and has satisfactorily met all of its local, state, and federal tax filing and tax payment responsibilities.”

**SECTION 2.** That all formal actions of this Council concerning the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting, and all deliberations of this Council, or any of its Committees, which resulted in such formal actions, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**WHEREFORE**, this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon the earliest date allowable by law.
